# **CAMO AT A GLANCE** 2023-2024

Key Impacts of CAMO USA's Support for CAMO Honduras: CAMO USA played a vital role in supporting CAMO Honduras by sending \$2.5 million in supplies and equipment, collected and prepared by 66 dedicated volunteers. This included 9 containers with 16,504 boxes and 282 pieces of equipment, benefitting 108 institutions across 18 departments. CAMO USA's contributions have strengthened healthcare, education, and community services in underserved areas, reducing operational costs and enabling CAMO Honduras to expand critical programs.

# YOUR DONATIONS HAVE HELPED OUR PROGRAMS GROW THIS YEAR

#### Impact of Medical Services:

- CAMO provided 7,774 disability treatments, enhancing independence for many.
- Through 196 brigades, CAMO reached rural communities with 11,510 dental and medical services.
- Key advancements in gastroenterology, cataract surgery, and neurosurgery positioned CAMO as a leader in specialized healthcare.

#### Impact on Women's Health Services:

- CAMO enhanced women's health by conducting 22 mammography brigades.
- Installing two mammography machines, and screening 1,504 women.
- During Cervical Cancer Prevention Week, CAMO provided cytology screenings and education on cancer prevention.
- Additionally, CAMO's pathology program performed 35,301 procedures, supporting early detection and treatment for women's health.

#### Most Impactful Achievements in Education and Training:

CAMO enhanced life-saving skills with 3,873 students trained in emergency care sessions.

VOLUNTEERS IN HONDURAS


- Trained 543 youth in CPR and nursing.
- Through partnerships, CAMO developed a national Respiratory Therapy curriculum set for 2026.
- Support for 16 rural schools included teacher training, literacy programs, and health screenings, benefiting 1,710 children.

# Most Impactful Achievements in Community Partnership:

- CAMO provided shelter and support for 104 women and children at Casa Hogar, while educating 2,000 on gender-based violence.
  - Empowered 1,419 students through technical courses at the Trade School, fostering job opportunities.
  - Invested over \$45,370 in upgrading the Hospital de Occidente's Emergency Room to improve patient care.


