THE GASTROENTEROLOGY PROGRAM

In 2024, the CAMO Gastroenterology Program provided 1,090 vital treatments for numerous digestive conditions. With only 25 gastroenterologists in all of Honduras, CAMO is fortunate to have three Honduran specialists generously donating their time to this program. Thanks to donations of essential equipment, materials, and supplies, this dedicated team tirelessly treats both children and adults facing a wide range of digestive health issues.

Aurora, a recent patient, had been suffering from persistent abdominal pain. One day, her condition worsened significantly, prompting a four hour drive to our program. Upon arrival, she was immediately admitted to the ICU for a life-threatening upper gastrointestinal (GI) bleed. Her life was saved through a banding procedure performed by gastroenterologist Dr. Candy Leiva, one of our devoted volunteers. Without this treatment she would not have survived.

Many patients like Aurora require follow-up surgeries to provide vessel banding, a procedure that prevents future bleeding. Unfortunately, these banding kits cost between \$50 and \$200 each, and some patients may need multiple procedures. For low-income families, the initial surgery is often life-saving, but follow-up care can be out of reach due to financial constraints.

Your generous financial and in-kind support ensures that every patient who walks through our doors receives the care they need. Aurora's recovery is just one of many examples of how your contributions directly save lives.
